PhD Reading Course: The Classics in Evolutionary Biology

Instructors: Nick Barton and Jonathan Bollback

Overview:

This course is an introduction to the 'classic' works in the major areas of evolutionary biology. The reading curriculum follows the historical development of the field, thus providing an understanding of progress in evolutionary biology up to the present. The goal is to give an introduction to a variety of topics, and to provide experience in giving oral presentations and writing scientific essays.

Course schedule:

The course will meet 2 hours per week, for 12 weeks.

Student responsibilities:

Each student will select 2-3 of the readings from the list. For each of these, they will be responsible for giving an oral presentation of the work, and a written essay.
